



Please read the following rules for attending class.

We want everyone to be safe and have a great experience!

We will observe a no-contact policy -- dog/dog, person/dog, person/person.

- Everyone will park in the rear of the building as in the past.
- Per our previous policy — if you, or your dog, do not feel well please stay home and email your instructor.
- Face coverings are no longer required in indoor public spaces within the Town of Acton. The Board, however, strongly advises everyone to follow the Massachusetts Department of Public Health guidelines that were issued on February 15, 2022 and are available below:

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts – Advisory regarding face coverings

Effective February 15, 2022: A fully vaccinated individual should wear a face covering indoors if you have a weakened immune system, or if you are at increased risk for severe disease because of your age or an underlying medical condition, or if someone in your household has a weakened immune system, is at increased risk for severe disease or is unvaccinated. Please wait in the parking lot with your dog and bring the minimum gear needed for class into the building (6' leash, treats, clicker (except for Puppy Obedience and Beginner Obedience week 1), water bottle/dish for you and your dog).

- Your Instructor will open the door and invite you to come in via single file with 6' distance between students to your training ring.
- Two people may now attend a class with their dog – chairs will be available outside the ring with six foot distance between chairs.
- Once your class is in the building the back door will be locked. Plan your commute time appropriately — late arrivals will not be able to enter.
- Class size is limited to make certain we provide 12'-14' between dog/handler teams and instructors.
- Make certain to maintain at least a 6' social distance at all times when you are in our facility.
- There will be a dispenser of hand sanitizer and wipes in each ring. Normal cleanup supplies will be available for doggie messes as in the past.
- If you need to pay for class do so as you normally have in the past.
- At the end of class your instructor will supervise leaving the building via the front door. Follow the sidewalk around the building to your car in the back parking lot.

Please be patient and flexible, this is TOUGH on everyone and we are ALL trying to be safe while maintaining our ability to hold classes for you and your dog.
